



Suggested Text to Promote Cal EITC in Your Newsletter and/or Website

Eligible low-income working California families can receive a total of up to \$6,000 in cash simply by filing tax returns.

The money is available through the state and federal Earned Income Tax Credits.

During this past year, nearly \$5.8 million worth of Cal EITC money alone went to San Joaquin County residents.
