California Air Resources Board

Clean Vehicle Rebate Project (CVRP)

Rebates for purchase or lease of new zero-emission and plug-in hybrid vehicles

Eligibility: Individuals, businesses, non-profit organizations, government

Enhanced Fleet Modernization Program (EFMP) & Plus-Up Pilot Project

Rebates to replace old polluting cars with cleaner, more fuel-efficient cars

Eligibility: Residents of disadvantaged communities that meet low-income requirements in the Greater Los Angeles Area and San Joaquin Valley

Woodsmoke Reduction Program (NEW for 2016)

Woodsmoke Reduction Program will replace existing, uncertified residential wood burning devices used to heat homes with cleaner, more efficient heating devices

Eligibility: Households with uncertified residential wood burning devices, additional details will be available in the future

Installation of solar systems, solar water heaters and energy efficiency measures

California State Transportation Agency

Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Program (TIRCP)

Funding for capital improvements to modernize and integrate transit and rail systems for increased, reliable and connected service
