

Policies and Programs (Action Plan)

- Adequate Sites and Zoning for a Variety of Housing Types
- Assist in the Development of Housing for Lower and Moderate Income Households
- Address and Remove Governmental Constraints
- Conserve and Improve the Affordable Housing Stock
- Preserve At-risk Housing
- Promote Housing Opportunities for All Persons

- New HCD Enforcement Provisions (AB 72)






Authorizes enforcement of state housing-planning ("housing element") law and enable HCD to refer any violations to the Attorney General.


